Manifest of arrival from Mexico, at Laredo, Texas says he was coming to join his brother Antonio.<sup>894</sup>, Romo-Ignacio Arrival 1920.jpg Unfortunately, no record for a brother named Antonio has yet turned up. His entry manifest from 1920 and declaration of intent from 1939 both give his birth year as 1899, indirectly by age and directly by birth date. This conflicts with the record on file of 1902. The choice of Edwarda as the name of the last born child, the same as his mother's, supports his identity as the Ignacio born in 1902.

According to various records, Mariano's birth year was either 1825, 1831, or 1835. The marriage to Juana Beltrán in January of 1845, was preceded by a consent agreement by both fathers for Mariano, age 19, and Juana, age 16, to get married. This is probably because they were both "under age." If Mariano were born in 1831, he would have been only 14 in 1845, and almost certainly too young to marry even with consent. Thus, his age of 58 in his death record of 1889 has to be in error, as that would give a birth year of 1831. The death record also mistakenly names his father as Nepomuseno. All other documents related to Mariano identify his father as Estevan. His baptismal record lists Godparents ("Padri") as Nepamuceno and Micaela de la Rosa, with the phrase "aqui en [b erti] su parentesco." (*Meaning of the portion in brackets is unclear. Parentesco is kinship.*)

A birth/baptism record has not been found, but some baptism records of his children list Ygnacio Romo and Joachina/Juachina Mora as paternal grandparents, establishing the generational link.

His name is recorded as Jph Maria Romo in the baptism of son Joseph (Jph) [José] Julian.

The family tree on Familysearch gives a birth year of 1770, but given the marriage in 1782 a birth year of ~1760 seems more reasonable.

A son named Marcos is listed in the online family tree at Familysearch, but there doesn't seem to be a baptism (1800) record for him. It's not on the same page as Joseph Guillermo, also born 1800, who would apparently be his twin.

Another son, also named José Maria Romo, b. 1810, is in the Familysearch tree, but doesn't seem to have a baptism record. There is a marriage record with Maria de Jesus de Villalobos on 25 February 1827, with José Maria Romo and Maria Moran as his parents.<sup>897, Romo-Villalobos Marr 1827.jpg</sup>

The marriage was announced in the church on 13, 20, and 27 January 1782 between Don José Maria Romo de Vivar and Doña Maria Moran y Españoles (ie. Not Indios). The use of Don and Doña suggests they were in the upper level of society at the time. Theirs is the only marriage record of four on the page to use those terms.
